SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 41 – Governor – Executive and Administrative Departments

18-305.

(a) There is a Commission on Complementary Medical Methods which shall define which health care methods are complementary medical methods and study how to allow the use of complementary medical methods by Maryland physicians ~~and other health care providers~~ with patients who wish to be treated through complementary methods for their medical conditions.

(f) The Commission shall report its findings and recommendations to the Governor and, subject to § 2-1312 of the State Government Article, to the General Assembly by December 1, [1994] 1995 and thereafter terminate its existence.
