CHAPTER 163

(Senate Bill 268)

AN ACT concerning

Board of Property Review

FOR the purpose of altering which judges shall designate the individuals to serve on a board of property review instead of an absent or disqualified member of the board; and generally relating to the condemnation of property for highway construction.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Section 8-328(b)

Annotated Code of Maryland

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Transportation

8-328.

(b) Unless all parties in a case certified to a board agree otherwise, the full board shall hear and decide the case. If a member of the board is absent or disqualified from hearing or deciding any case, the judges of the [judicial circuit] COURT THAT APPOINTED THE BOARD shall designate another [person] INDIVIDUAL with qualifications similar to those of the absent or disqualified member to serve [in his place] INSTEAD.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1994.

CHAPTER 164

(Senate Bill 315)

AN ACT concerning

Drunk Driving – Compulsory Alcohol Test

FOR the purpose of requiring a person who is involved in a motor vehicle accident
