SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

The County Commissioners of Cecil County, in addition to regularly scheduled weekday meetings, shall hold a public meeting one evening of each week to transact official business.]

THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, IN ADDITION TO REGULARLY SCHEDULED WEEKDAY MEETINGS, MAY HOLD A PUBLIC MEETING ONE EVENING OF EACH WEEK TO TRANSACT OFFICIAL BUSINESS.
