- (k) (1) The Sheriff of Dorchester County shall receive [a] AN ANNUAL salary of [\$35,000, and] \$45,000. THE SHERIFF SHALL be allowed the actual cost of the maintenance of automobiles and the county jail. The Sheriff shall appoint a chief deputy sheriff, one assistant deputy sheriff, other deputies, and a jail matron if approved by the County Commissioners. A deputy or matron shall receive the compensation provided in the county budget.
- (2) If the Sheriff becomes incapacitated and the position of chief deputy is vacant, the County Commissioners shall appoint a chief deputy sheriff.
