- (o) (1) (I) The Sheriff of Howard County shall receive [a] AN ANNUAL salary [of \$38,000] AS FOLLOWS:
 - 1. \$39,500 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 1995;
 - 2. \$41,000 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 1996;
 - 3. \$42,500 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 1997; AND
 - 4. \$44,000 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 1998 AND THEREAFTER.
- (II) The Sheriff shall appoint the number of deputies authorized by the County government. The compensation of the deputies shall be set by the County government. A deputy holds office at the pleasure of the Sheriff and may be removed by the Sheriff at any time or by the Circuit Court for Howard County upon indictment and conviction as provided by law. The Sheriff may appoint additional temporary deputy sheriffs when necessary for the public safety and the County government shall allow them reasonable compensation. These deputies may not serve longer than the case actually requires.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, Section 35 of the Constitution of Maryland, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the salary or compensation of the Howard County Sheriff in office on the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or compensation of the Howard County Sheriff shall take effect at the beginning of the next following term of office.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1994.
