

(4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds as and when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years after the date of issuance of the bonds.

(5) (a) Prior to the issuance of the bonds, the Enoch Pratt Free Library shall grant and convey to the Maryland Historical Trust a perpetual preservation easement to the extent of its interest:

(i) On the land or such portion of the land acceptable to the Trust;
and

(ii) On the exterior and interior, where appropriate, of the historic structures.

(b) The easement must be in form and substance acceptable to the Trust and the extent of the interest to be encumbered must be acceptable to the Trust.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1994.

CHAPTER 342

(House Bill 1456)

AN ACT concerning

Charles County – Treasurer

FOR the purpose of altering the salary of the Treasurer for Charles County; providing that this Act does not apply to the salary of the incumbent Treasurer; maintaining the salary established in a previous Act; and generally relating to the salary of the Treasurer for Charles County.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
