SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Business Occupations and Professions

TITLE 17. SECURITY SYSTEMS TECHNICIANS

SUBTITLE 1. DEFINITIONS, GENERAL PROVISIONS

17-101.

(A) IN THIS TITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

(B) “LICENSE” MEANS A LICENSE ISSUED BY THE SUPERINTENDENT OR THE SUPERINTENDENT’S DESIGNEE TO ENGAGE IN THE BUSINESS OF PROVIDING SECURITY SYSTEMS SERVICES FOR COMPENSATION.

(C) “PROVIDING SECURITY SYSTEMS SERVICES” MEANS:
