

(B) IN ADDITION TO ANY DUTIES SET FORTH ELSEWHERE, THE SUPERINTENDENT SHALL:

(1) ADOPT REGULATIONS THAT SET STANDARDS FOR THE LICENSURE OF A SECURITY SYSTEMS TECHNICIAN; AND

(2) KEEP A ROSTER OF INDIVIDUALS LICENSED AS SECURITY SYSTEMS TECHNICIANS.

THE SUPERINTENDENT AND ALL MEMBERS OF THE MARYLAND STATE POLICE:

(1) SHALL TREAT AS CONFIDENTIAL ANY INFORMATION OBTAINED THROUGH AN INVESTIGATION OF AN APPLICANT FOR A LICENSE UNDER THIS TITLE; AND

(2) UNLESS REQUIRED BY A COURT ORDER, MAY NOT DIVULGE TO A PERSON WHO IS NOT A MEMBER OF THE MARYLAND STATE POLICE ANY INFORMATION OBTAINED THROUGH AN INVESTIGATION OF AN APPLICANT FOR A LICENSE UNDER THIS TITLE.

~~EXCEPT FOR FEES SPECIFICALLY SET BY THIS TITLE, THE SUPERINTENDENT MAY SET REASONABLE FEES FOR THE ISSUANCE AND RENEWAL OF LICENSES.~~

THE SUPERINTENDENT SHALL PAY ALL MONEY COLLECTED UNDER THIS TITLE INTO THE GENERAL FUND OF THE STATE.

SUBTITLE 3. LICENSING

17-301.

(A) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS TITLE, A PERSON SHALL BE LICENSED BY THE SUPERINTENDENT AS A SECURITY SYSTEMS TECHNICIAN BEFORE THE PERSON MAY ENGAGE IN THE BUSINESS OF PROVIDING SECURITY SYSTEMS SERVICES IN THE STATE.

(B) A PERSON WHO SELLS SECURITY SYSTEMS AT THE PROTECTED PREMISES OR THE PREMISES TO BE PROTECTED BUT DOES NOT INSTALL, MAINTAIN, OR REPAIR THOSE SYSTEMS:

(1) IS NOT REQUIRED TO BE LICENSED UNDER THIS TITLE; BUT

(2) IS REQUIRED TO:

(I) REGISTER WITH THE SUPERINTENDENT ONCE EVERY 2 YEARS;

(II) PROVIDE THE INFORMATION THE SUPERINTENDENT REQUIRES; AND

(III) PAY A FEE OF \$15.
