(C) EACH LICENSEE SHALL GIVE THE SUPERINTENDENT WRITTEN NOTICE OF ANY CHANGE OF ADDRESS WITHIN 10 DAYS AFTER THE CHANGE.

SUBJECT TO THE HEARING PROVISIONS OF § 17–310 OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE SUPERINTENDENT MAY DENY A LICENSE TO ANY APPLICANT, REPRIMAND ANY LICENSEE, OR SUSPEND OR REVOKE A LICENSE IF THE APPLICANT OR LICENSEE:

- (1) FRAUDULENTLY OR DECEPTIVELY OBTAINS OR ATTEMPTS TO OBTAIN A LICENSE FOR THE APPLICANT OR LICENSEE OR FOR ANOTHER;
 - (2) FRAUDULENTLY OR DECEPTIVELY USES A LICENSE;
- (3) HAS A SIMILAR LICENSE DENIED, SUSPENDED, OR REVOKED IN ANOTHER JURISDICTION;
- (4) PLEADS GUILTY OR NOLO CONTENDERE TO OR IS CONVICTED OF A FELONY, THEFT OFFENSE, OR CRIME OF MORAL TURPITUDE;
- (3) (5) AIDS AN INDIVIDUAL TO OBTAIN OR TO ATTEMPT TO OBTAIN FRAUDULENTLY OR DECEPTIVELY LICENSURE UNDER THIS TITLE AS A SECURITY SYSTEMS TECHNICIAN;
- (4) (6) WHILE NOT LICENSED, WILLFULLY ENGAGES IN A BUSINESS PROVIDING SECURITY SYSTEMS SERVICES;
- (5) (7) WHILE NOT LICENSED, WILLFULLY ADVERTISES AS A SECURITY SYSTEMS TECHNICIAN:
- (6) (8) WILLFULLY MAKES A FALSE STATEMENT OR MISREPRESENTATION IN ANY RENEWAL APPLICATION OR IN ANY OTHER DOCUMENT THAT THE SUPERINTENDENT REQUIRES TO BE SUBMITTED; OR
- (7) (9) VIOLATES ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS TITLE.
- (A) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN TITLE 10, SUBTITLE 4 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, BEFORE THE SUPERINTENDENT TAKES ANY FINAL ACTION UNDER § 17–309 OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE SUPERINTENDENT SHALL GIVE THE PERSON AGAINST WHOM THE ACTION IS CONTEMPLATED AN OPPORTUNITY FOR A HEARING BEFORE THE SUPERINTENDENT.
- (B) THE SUPERINTENDENT SHALL GIVE NOTICE AND HOLD THE HEARING IN ACCORDANCE WITH TITLE 10, SUBTITLE 2 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.
- (C) THE HEARING NOTICE TO BE GIVEN TO THE INDIVIDUAL SHALL BE SENT BY CERTIFIED MAIL TO THE LAST KNOWN ADDRESS OF THE INDIVIDUAL AT LEAST 10 DAYS BEFORE THE HEARING.
- (D) THE SUPERINTENDENT MAY ADMINISTER OATHS IN CONNECTION WITH ANY PROCEEDING UNDER THIS SECTION.
