SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted.

**CHAPTER 366**

**(House Bill 636)**

AN ACT concerning

**Crofton Police Department**

FOR the purpose of codifying provisions relating to the Crofton Police Department; specifying that the Crofton Police Department is not an agency of Anne Arundel County; specifying that Anne Arundel County is not responsible for certain acts or omissions; specifying the powers and the duties of the Crofton Police Department; requiring the Maryland Police Training Commission, or a certain designee, to adopt certain standards; requiring that those members of the Crofton Police Department who meet the requirements of the Police Training Commission shall be certified by the Commission; granting the Crofton Police Department certain powers of warrantless arrest; making members of the Crofton Police Department subject to the Law Enforcement Officers' Bill of Rights; requiring that a member of the Crofton Police Department be notified of possible contact with certain diseases under certain circumstances; and generally relating to the powers and rights of the officers of the Crofton Police Department.
