- (4) ACCEPT THE COMPLETED VOTER REGISTRATION APPLICATION FORMS FOR TRANSMITTAL TO THE APPROPRIATE ELECTION BOARD.
- (C) AN APPLICANT MAY MAIL THE VOTER REGISTRATION APPLICATION TO THE APPROPRIATE STATE ELECTION OFFICIAL OR RETURN IT TO THE VOTER REGISTRATION AGENCY FOR TRANSMITTAL TO THE APPROPRIATE STATE ELECTION OFFICIAL.
- (C) THE FORMS SHALL BE FORWARDED WITHIN 10 DAYS OF ACCEPTANCE. HOWEVER, IF A FORM IS ACCEPTED WITHIN 5 DAYS OF THE LAST DAY FOR VOTER REGISTRATION, THE FORM SHALL BE FORWARDED WITHIN 5 DAYS.
- (D) (1) WITHIN 10 DAYS FROM THE ACCEPTANCE OF A VOTER REGISTRATION APPLICATION, THE VOTER REGISTRATION AGENCY SHALL FORWARD THE APPLICATION TO THE APPROPRIATE STATE ELECTION OFFICIAL.
- (2) IF THE VOTER REGISTRATION AGENCY ACCEPTS AN APPLICATION WITHIN 5 DAYS BEFORE A VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINE, THE VOTER REGISTRATION AGENCY SHALL FORWARD THE APPLICATION TO THE APPROPRIATE STATE OFFICIAL NO LATER THAN 5 DAYS FROM THE DATE OF ACCEPTANCE.
- (D) (E) IF A VOTER REGISTRATION AGENCY IS AN OFFICE DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (A)(2)(II) OF THIS SECTION, WHICH PROVIDES SERVICES TO A PERSON WITH A DISABILITY AT A PERSON'S HOME, THE AGENCY SHALL PROVIDE THE SERVICES DESCRIBED AT THE PERSON'S HOME.
- $\frac{(E)}{(F)}$ (1) A PERSON WHO PROVIDES ANY SERVICE DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION MAY NOT:
- (I) SEEK TO INFLUENCE AN APPLICANT'S POLITICAL PREFERENCE OR PARTY REGISTRATION;
- (II) DISPLAY ANY SUCH POLITICAL PREFERENCE OR PARTY ALLEGIANCE;
- (III) MAKE ANY STATEMENT TO AN APPLICANT OR TAKE ANY ACTION THE PURPOSE OR EFFECT OF WHICH IS TO LEAD THE APPLICANT TO BELIEVE THAT A DECISION TO REGISTER OR NOT TO REGISTER HAS ANY BEARING ON THE AVAILABILITY OF SERVICES OR BENEFITS.
- (2) NO INFORMATION RELATING TO A DECLINATION TO REGISTER TO VOTE IN CONNECTION WITH AN APPLICATION MADE AT AN OFFICE DESIGNATED AS A VOTER REGISTRATION AGENCY MAY BE USED FOR ANY PURPOSE OTHER THAN VOTER REGISTRATION.
- (3) NOTWITHSTANDING § 3-11 OF THIS ARTICLE AND § 10-611 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, THE IDENTITY OF A VOTER REGISTRATION AGENCY THROUGH WHICH A PARTICULAR VOTER HAS REGISTERED MAY NOT BE DISCLOSED TO THE PUBLIC.
