

(2) AS PROVIDED BY STATE LAW, BY REASON OF CRIMINAL CONVICTION, OR GUARDIANSHIP FOR MENTAL DISABILITY;

(3) UPON A DETERMINATION UNDER § 3-18 OF THIS SUBTITLE THAT A REGISTRANT HAS DIED; OR

(4) SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, A CHANGE OF RESIDENCE.

(B) (1) EACH ELECTION BOARD SHALL PERIODICALLY MAKE A REASONABLE EFFORT TO REMOVE PERSONS FROM THE VOTER ROLL WHO HAVE BECOME INELIGIBLE BY REASON OF A CHANGE OF ADDRESS.

(2) THE PROCESS USED BY AN ELECTION BOARD TO IDENTIFY, NOTIFY, AND REMOVE ~~VOTERS~~ REGISTRANTS WHO HAVE BECOME INELIGIBLE BY REASON OF A CHANGE OF ADDRESS SHALL BE APPROVED BY THE STATE ADMINISTRATIVE BOARD OF ELECTION LAWS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISION OF THIS SECTION.

(3) THE PROCESS OF PERIODICALLY REMOVING INELIGIBLE ~~VOTERS~~ REGISTRANTS FROM THE VOTER ROLL SHALL BE COMPLETED AT LEAST 90 DAYS BEFORE AN ELECTION.

(4) ~~(4)~~ UPON IDENTIFYING A ~~VOTER~~ REGISTRANT WHO HAS REPORTEDLY CHANGED RESIDENCE WITHIN THE SAME REGISTRAR'S JURISDICTION, AN ELECTION BOARD SHALL CHANGE THE REGISTRANT'S ADDRESS AND SEND THE ~~VOTER~~ REGISTRANT A NOTICE APPROVED BY THE STATE BOARD. THE NOTICE SHALL BE SENT BY FORWARDABLE MAIL WITH A POSTAGE PREPAID AND PREAMDRESSED RETURN CARD ON WHICH THE ~~VOTER~~ REGISTRANT MAY REPORT THE PERSON'S CURRENT ADDRESS.

(5) (I) IF IT APPEARS FROM INFORMATION PROVIDED BY THE POSTAL SERVICE THAT A REGISTRANT HAS MOVED TO A DIFFERENT RESIDENCE NOT WITHIN THE SAME REGISTRAR'S JURISDICTION, AN ELECTION BOARD SHALL SEND THE REGISTRANT A NOTICE APPROVED BY THE STATE ADMINISTRATIVE BOARD OF ELECTION LAWS. THE NOTICE SHALL BE SENT BY FORWARDABLE RETURN MAIL WITH A POSTAGE PREPAID AND PREAMDRESSED RETURN CARD ON WHICH THE REGISTRANT MAY STATE THE REGISTRANT'S CURRENT ADDRESS.

(II) THE NOTICE APPROVED BY THE STATE BOARD SHALL ADVISE ~~VOTERS~~ REGISTRANTS OF THEIR POTENTIAL INACTIVE STATUS AS DESCRIBED IN PARAGRAPH (7) OF THIS SUBSECTION.

~~(5)~~ (6) UPON RECEIPT OF THE RETURN CARD DESCRIBED IN PARAGRAPH (4) OF THIS SUBSECTION, AN ELECTION BOARD SHALL MAKE ANY NEEDED CORRECTIONS IN ITS RECORDS TO REFLECT THE ~~VOTER'S~~ REGISTRANT'S CURRENT RESIDENCE.

~~(6)~~ (7) A BOARD MAY NOT REMOVE A ~~VOTER~~ REGISTRANT FROM THE VOTER ROLL ON THE GROUNDS OF A CHANGE OF ADDRESS UNLESS:
