- (I) THE  $\frac{\text{VOTER}}{\text{REGISTRANT}}$  CONFIRMS IN WRITING THAT THE  $\frac{\text{VOTER}}{\text{REGISTRANT}}$  HAS CHANGED RESIDENCE TO A LOCATION OUTSIDE THE COUNTY OR BALTIMORE CITY IN WHICH THE  $\frac{\text{VOTER}}{\text{REGISTRANT}}$  IS REGISTERED; OR
- (II) 1. THE <del>VOTER</del> <u>REGISTRANT</u> HAS FAILED TO RESPOND TO THE NOTICE REQUIRED BY PARAGRAPH (4) OF THIS SUBSECTION; AND
- 2. THE <u>VOTER REGISTRANT</u> HAS NOT VOTED OR APPEARED TO VOTE (AND, IF NECESSARY, CORRECTED THE RECORD OF THE <u>VOTER'S REGISTRANT'S</u> ADDRESS) IN AN ELECTION DURING THE PERIOD BEGINNING WITH THE DATE OF THE NOTICE THROUGH THE NEXT TWO GENERAL ELECTIONS.
- (7) (8) (I) IF A PERSON FAILS TO RESPOND TO A NOTICE CONCERNING A CHANGE OF RESIDENCE DESCRIBED IN PARAGRAPH (5) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE PERSON'S NAME SHALL BE PLACED ON A LIST OF INACTIVE VOTERS.
- (II) UPON PROOF WRITTEN AFFIRMATION THAT AN INACTIVE VOTER REMAINS A RESIDENT OF THE SAME COUNTY OR BALTIMORE CITY AND THE SAME CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT, THE VOTER MAY BE ALLOWED TO VOTE EITHER AT THE POLLING PLACE FOR THE VOTER'S CURRENT RESIDENCE OR THE VOTER'S PREVIOUS RESIDENCE, AS DETERMINED BY THE STATE ADMINISTRATIVE BOARD OF ELECTION LAWS, AND SHALL BE RESTORED TO THE ACTIVE ROLL. A VOTER'S DECLARATION OF RESIDENCE IS SUBJECT TO THE PENALTIES OF PERJURY.
- (III) AN INACTIVE VOTER WHO FAILS TO VOTE IN AN ELECTION IN THE PERIOD ENDING WITH THE SECOND GENERAL ELECTION SHALL BE REMOVED FROM THE VOTER ROLL.
- (IV) REGISTRANTS PLACED ON THE INACTIVE LIST ARE TO SHALL BE COUNTED ONLY FOR PURPOSES OF VOTING AND NOT FOR SUCH OFFICIAL ADMINISTRATIVE PURPOSES AS PETITION SIGNATURE VERIFICATION, ESTABLISHING PRECINCTS, AND REPORTING OFFICIAL STATISTICS.
- (8) (9) THE STATE ADMINISTRATOR OF ELECTION LAWS SHALL NOTIFY THE APPROPRIATE ELECTION BOARD CONCERNING INFORMATION ON FELONY CONVICTIONS RECEIVED FROM UNITED STATES AUTHORITIES.
- (9) (10) (I) EACH BOARD SHALL MAINTAIN FOR AT LEAST 2 YEARS, RECORDS CONCERNING PROGRAMS TO INSURE THAT ACCURACY AND CURRENCY OF THE VOTER ROLL. THESE RECORDS SHALL INCLUDE THE IDENTITY OF PERSONS TO WHOM THE NOTICE REQUIRED IN PARAGRAPH (4) OF THIS SUBSECTION IS SENT AND WHETHER THERE WAS A RESPONSE.
- (II) EXCEPT FOR RECORDS CONCERNING A DECLINATION TO REGISTER OR THE IDENTITY OF A VOTER REGISTRATION AGENCY THROUGH WHICH A PARTICULAR VOTER REGISTERS, THE RECORDS DESCRIBED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH ARE ACCESSIBLE UNDER TITLE 10, SUBTITLE 6, PART III OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE (ACCESS TO PUBLIC RECORDS).
