CHAPTER 384

(House Bill 807)

AN ACT concerning

Upper Chesapeake Watershed Association - Property Tax Exemption Credit

FOR the purpose of exempting from authorizing the governing body of Cecil County and of a municipal corporation in Cecil County to grant a property tax credit against property taxes levied on property that is owned by the Upper Chesapeake Watershed Association and used for specified purposes; and providing for the application of this Act.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Tax - Property

7-218.1

PROPERTY IS NOT SUBJECT TO PROPERTY TAX IF THE PROPERTY:

- (1) IS OWNED BY THE UPPER CHESAPEAKE WATERSHED ASSOCIATION; AND
 - (2) IS-USED:
 - (I) TO ASSIST IN THE PRESERVATION OF A WILD NATURE AREA;
 - (II) TO ESTABLISH A NATURE RESERVE OR OTHER PROTECTED

AREA: OR

(III) GENERALLY TO PROMOTE CONSERVATION:

- (A) The governing body of Cecil County and of a municipal corporation in Cecil County shall grant a property tax credit under this section against the county and municipal corporation property tax imposed on:
- (1) property that is owned by the Society for the Preservation of Maryland Antiquities, Incorporated; and
- (2) property that is owned by the Friends of the Library of Cecil County, Maryland, Incorporated.
