SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

19.

- (r) (1) This subsection (r) applies only in Prince George's County.
- (11) (i) 1. In this paragraph the following words have the meanings indicated.
 - 2. "Board" means the Board of License Commissioners.
- 3. "Commission" means the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission.
- (ii) 1. The Board may issue a special 7-day Class B-ECR (Equestrian Center restaurant) on-sale beer, wine and liquor license for the exclusive use on the premises of the Commission's Equestrian Center restaurant located within Prince George's County.
- 2. The special 7-day Class B-ECR on-sale beer, wine and liquor license authorizes the sale of beer, wine, and liquor by the drink for consumption on the restaurant premises by the holder or a private concessionaire under contract with the holder to operate the licensed premises.
- (iii) 1. A special 7-day Class B-ECR on-sale beer, wine and liquor license shall be issued to the Commission for use in the Commission's Equestrian Center restaurant upon the Commission's making application and qualifying as a license holder under this article.
- 2. The residency requirement under § 40 of this article does not apply to an applicant for this license under this paragraph.
- (iv) Any profit made from the sale of beer, wine, and liquor by the holder of a license issued pursuant to this paragraph may be for the use and benefit of the Commission.
- (v) The annual fee for the special 7-day Class B-ECR (Equestrian Center restaurant) on-sale beer, wine and liquor license is [\$1,080] \$2,000.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1994.
