- (ii) The off-sale privilege authorizes the holder to sell and deliver beer brewed under this license to:
- 1. Any wholesaler licensed under this article to sell beer in this State; or
- 2. Any person who is located in a state other than Maryland who is authorized under the laws of that state to receive brewed beverages.
- (iii) In Baltimore City AND PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY only, the holder [is authorized to] MAY sell at retail beer brewed under this license to customers for consumption off the licensed premises in refillable containers that are sealed by the micro-brewery licensee at the time of each refill.
 - (4) A holder of a Class 7 micro-brewery license:
- (i) May not own, operate or be affiliated with any other manufacturer of beer; and
- (ii) Notwithstanding subsection (h) of this section, may not be granted a wholesale alcoholic beverages license.
- (5) The days and time of consumer sales under this license are as established for a Class B license in [Baltimore City and Dorchester County] THE JURISDICTIONS LISTED IN PARAGRAPH (1)(II) OF THIS SUBSECTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1994.

(House Bill 1127)
