

(d) (1) The terms of the members who are not cabinet members, or who do not represent the Maryland Disability Law Center or the Office on Aging, shall be 4 years beginning July 1, 1986.

(2) Each member of the Board shall serve without compensation but shall be entitled to reimbursement for expenses under Standard State Travel Regulations.

(e) The Board may establish its own procedures and voting requirements.

(f) The Departments of Health and Mental Hygiene, Human Resources, and the Office [of Planning] ON AGING shall provide the Board with the necessary staff and support services.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1994.

Weights and Measures Inspection – Coordination
