

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section(s) 2-313(h), (i), and (j), respectively, of Article 83B - Department of Housing and Community Development of the Annotated Code of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 2-313(g), (h), and (i), respectively.

CHAPTER 440
(House Bill 1480)

AN ACT concerning

Medical Assistance Program - Family Planning Program

FOR the purpose of providing family planning services to postpartum women who lose eligibility for Medical Assistance under the Pregnant Women and Children's Program; and generally relating to family planning services.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Health - General

15-103.

(a) (1) The Secretary shall administer the Maryland Medical Assistance Program.

(2) The Program:

(i) Shall provide comprehensive medical and other health care for indigent individuals or medically indigent individuals or both;

(ii) Shall provide, subject to the limitations of the State budget and the availability of federal funds, comprehensive medical and other health care for all pregnant women and, at a minimum, all children currently under the age of 1 whose family income falls below 185 percent of the poverty level, as permitted by the federal law;
