SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Transportation

7-801.

Anne Arundel County, CARROLL COUNTY, FREDERICK COUNTY, Howard County, and Montgomery County may:

(1) Levy and collect taxes for:

(i) The organization, operation, and maintenance of public transportation services; and

(ii) The purchase, sale, construction, maintenance, and operation of all real and personal property necessary or incidental to public transportation services; and

(2) Establish, modify, amend, and abolish special taxing areas for public transportation services.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED; That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1994.

CHAPTER 452

(House Bill 1655)

AN ACT concerning

Code Counties – Civil Infractions – Prosecutorial Authority

FOR the purpose of authorizing, subject to certain approval, the State's Attorney to designate in writing a county attorney and an assistant county attorney in code home rule counties to prosecute certain civil infractions; and providing that a county attorney or an assistant county attorney designated under this Act shall have, and be authorized to exercise, certain power and authority with respect to the prosecution of a civil infraction.
