SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted.

**CHAPTER 468**

**(Senate Bill 214)**

AN ACT concerning

**Pension Law – Cross-References**

FOR the purpose of correcting throughout the Annotated Code cross-references that will be rendered obsolete by Division II and Division III of the State Personnel and Pensions Article; conforming terminology in certain provisions to the terminology in the State Personnel and Pensions Article; making a certain technical correction in the State Personnel and Pensions Article; repealing provisions of law that restrict eligibility to purchase certain annuities under the Optional Retirement Program and the Maryland Teachers and State Employees Supplemental Retirement Plans; making stylistic changes; providing for the effects of this Act; providing for the effective dates of this Act; and generally relating to Division II and Division III of the State Personnel and Pensions Article.
