- (3) EXCEPT WITH RESPECT TO CLASSIFIED EMPLOYEE GRIEVANCE APPEALS, TITLE 10, SUBTITLES 1 AND 2 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE ("ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE ACT") ARE NOT APPLICABLE TO THE BOARD OF REGENTS.
- (c) The Board of Regents may review or adopt policies and procedures of the University with respect to:
 - (1) Accreditation;
 - (2) Programs and functions;
 - (3) Actual and potential capabilities;
 - (4) Admissions;
 - (5) Curricula;
 - (6) Graduation;
 - (7) The awarding of degrees; and
 - (8) General policymaking.
- (d) The Board of Regents may prepare and submit annual budgets and spend funds budgeted for nonsalary items on appropriate activities.
- (e) Subject to any applicable State law, rule, or regulation, the Board of Regents may contract with any person to receive or provide services, research, training, or demonstrations.
- (F) (1) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE EXPRESSLY PROVIDED IN THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE OR ANY OTHER PROVISION OF A LAW, ON THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE PRESIDENT, THE BOARD OF REGENTS SHALL ESTABLISH PROCUREMENT STANDARDS AND PROCEDURES FOR MORGAN STATE UNIVERSITY INCLUDING PROCEDURES FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF SUPPLIES FUNDED BY GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS.
- (2) THE STANDARDS AND PROCEDURES SHALL BE SUBMITTED TO THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS FOR APPROVAL NO LATER THAN 60 DAYS PRIOR TO THEIR EFFECTIVE DATE. IF NO REVIEW IS UNDERTAKEN WITHIN THE PERIOD, THE STANDARDS AND PROCEDURES SHALL BE CONSIDERED EFFECTIVE AT THE LAPSE OF THE PERIOD. THE PROCEDURES SHALL INCORPORATE THE FOLLOWING PROVISIONS OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE:
 - (I) §-11-205 (FRAUD IN PROCUREMENT);
- (II) § 10-204 (BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS APPROVAL FOR DESIGNATED CONTRACTS):

 - (IV) § 13-219 (REQUIRED CLAUSES NONDISCRIMINATION CLAUSE);
