

**CHAPTER 500**

**(Senate Bill 608)**

AN ACT concerning

**Regulated Shooting Grounds and Captive Wildlife — ~~Reporting and Penalties~~**

FOR the purpose of establishing certain reporting requirements for holders of permits to establish and operate regulated shooting grounds; making these reporting requirements a condition to receive certain new permits; authorizing the Secretary of Natural Resources to impose certain additional penalties on a certain permit holder for certain violations; requiring the Secretary to impose certain additional penalties on a certain permit holder for certain other violations occurring on a regulated shooting ground; establishing certain limits on the number of certain mallard ducks that may be taken by shooting on a regulated shooting ground; authorizing the hunting of certain pen-reared game birds on regulated shooting areas on Sundays under certain circumstances and in accordance with certain requirements and providing for the termination of this authorization; and generally relating to hunting on regulated shooting grounds and captive wildlife.
