SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- (b) (1) Except as provided in subsection (d) of this section, a person may not operate a vessel on the tidal ANY waters of the State so as to exceed a noise level of 75db(a), measured from a point on shore using generally accepted testing procedures imposed by regulations adopted by the Department based on the Marine Environment Sound Level Measurement Procedure, SAE J 1970.
- (2) (I) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION, A PERSON MAY NOT OPERATE A VESSEL ON THE NONTIDAL WATERS OF THE STATE SO AS TO EXCEED THE FOLLOWING NOISE LEVELS:
- 1. FOR ENGINES-MANUFACTURED-BEFORE JANUARY 1, 1993, A NOISE LEVEL OF 90DB(A); OR
- 2. <u>FOR ENGINES MANUFACTURED ON OR AFTER JANUARY</u> 1, 1993, A NOISE LEVEL OF 88DB(A).
