AN ACT concerning

## Injured Workers' Insurance Fund – Exemption From Laws Affecting Governmental Units <u>Fiscal Year</u> – Appointment and Employment of Attorneys

FOR the purpose of clarifying the provisions exempting, with certain express exceptions, the Injured Workers' Insurance Fund from any law affecting governmental units; providing that the calendar year is the fiscal year of the Fund beginning with calendar year 1994; and authorizing the Fund to appoint or employ attorneys.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article - Labor and Employment

10-105.

- (a) The Fund is independent of all State units.
- (b) (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection and elsewhere in this subtitle, the Fund is not subject to any law, INCLUDING § 6-106 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, that affects governmental units.
  - (2) The Fund is subject to:
    - (i) Title 10, Subtitle 5 of the State Government Article;
    - (ii) Title 10, Subtitle 6, Part III of the State Government Article;
    - (iii) Title 12 of the State Government Article;
    - (iv) the Maryland Public Ethics Law; and
    - (v) Title 3. Subtitle 3 of the State Personnel Article.
- (3) Paragraph (1) of this subsection does not affect the exemption from property tax under § 7-210 of the Tax Property Article.

BEGINNING WITH CALENDAR YEAR 1994, [The fiscal] THE CALENDAR year [of the State] is the fiscal year of the Fund.
