(House Bill 431)

AN ACT concerning

Alcohol-Related Driving Offenses - Modification of License Suspension - School Attendance

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Motor Vehicle Administration to issue a restrictive license, or to modify a driver's license suspension imposed on a licensee under the age of 21 for driving a motor vehicle while having a certain alcohol concentration as demonstrated by a certain test, to allow the person to drive to and from certain schools under certain circumstances; and generally relating to the modification of drivers' license suspensions.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16-205.1.

- (n) (1) The Administration may modify a suspension under this section or issue a restrictive license if:
 - (i) The licensee did not refuse to take a test;
- (ii) The licensee has not had a license suspended under this section during the past 5 years;
