

(3) AWARD GRANTS TO ELIGIBLE PRIVATE OR PUBLIC CONSORTIA TO ENABLE ELIGIBLE CONSORTIA TO DEVELOP STATE-OF-THE-ART TECHNOLOGY-ENHANCED INSTRUCTIONAL SYSTEMS FOR USE IN THE CLASSROOM, INCLUDING:

(I) THE DEVELOPMENT, PRODUCTION, AND DISTRIBUTION OF INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAMMING FOR STUDENTS;

(II) STAFF DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMMING FOR TEACHERS; AND

(III) INCORPORATION OF CREATIVE STATE-OF-THE-ART APPLICATIONS OF TECHNOLOGY-ENHANCED LEARNING RESOURCES, SUCH AS:

1. COMPUTER SOFTWARE;
2. DATABASES;
3. FILMS;
4. TRANSPARENCIES;
5. MULTIMEDIA VIDEO AND AUDIO DISCS;
6. TELECOMMUNICATIONS;
7. EDUCATIONAL TELEVISION; AND
8. PRINT RESOURCES.

IN AWARDING GRANTS UNDER § 7-704 OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT SHALL GIVE PRIORITY TO APPLICATIONS DESCRIBING PROGRAMS OR SYSTEMS THAT ARE DEVELOPED:

(1) FOR STATEWIDE APPLICATION AT A REASONABLE COST;

(2) IN CONSULTATION WITH CLASSROOM TEACHERS; AND

(3) THROUGH CONSULTATION AND COLLABORATION WITH APPROPRIATE EDUCATIONAL ENTITIES TO ENSURE RELEVANCE TO STATE CURRICULUM FRAMEWORKS.

(A) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, ANY ROYALTIES PAID TO ANY LOCAL EDUCATIONAL AGENCY AS A RESULT OF ASSISTANCE PROVIDED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE SHALL BE USED BY THE LOCAL EDUCATIONAL AGENCY FOR FURTHER DEVELOPMENT OF CURRICULUM-BASED LEARNING RESOURCES AUTHORIZED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.

(B) (1) THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT SHALL ALLOW AN ELIGIBLE CONSORTIUM TO RECEIVE A FINANCIAL BENEFIT FROM THE DISTRIBUTION OF PROGRAMMING ASSISTED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.
