7-201.

- (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.
- (b) "Administrator" means the Administrator of the Division.
- (c) "Code of Maryland Regulations" means the Code of Maryland Regulations and its permanent supplements.
- (d) "Committee" means the Joint Committee on Administrative, Executive, and Legislative Review.
  - (e) "CONTRACT WEEKLY" MEANS THE MARYLAND CONTRACT WEEKLY.
  - (F) "Division" means the Division of State Documents.
  - [(f)] (G) "Executive order" has the meaning stated in § 3-401 of this article.
  - [(g)](H) "Register" means the Maryland Register.
- [(h)](I) "Regulation" has the meaning stated in § 10–101 of this article, unless the context clearly requires otherwise.
- [(i)] (J) (1) "Unit" means an officer or unit in the Executive Branch of the State government that is authorized by law to adopt regulations or to adjudicate contested cases.
  - (2) "Unit" does not include a board of license commissioners.
