1994 LAWS OF MARYLAND

- (1) Two members shall have an initial term of 1 year;
- (2) Two members shall have an initial term of 2 years; and
- (3) One member shall have an initial term of 3 years.
- (b) The initial term of the consumer members of the Board shall be 3 years.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That any acupuncturist registered with the State Board of Physician Quality Assurance as of July 1, 1994, shall be deemed to be licensed under the provisions of this Act.

SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October July 1, 1994.

CHAPTER 621

(House Bill 973)

AN ACT concerning

Worcester County - Alcoholic Beverages (Fishing Club Licenses)

FOR the purpose of making available in Worcester County a Class C beer, wine and liquor license for fishing clubs; specifying conditions on obtaining such a license; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Worcester County.

- (y) (1) This subsection applies only in Worcester County.
 - (2) The annual license fee is \$250.
 - (3) There is a golf, tennis, or swimming club license which:
- (i) Is used in conjunction with a country club, excluding miniature golf courses operating in Worcester County;
