FOR the purpose of authorizing the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission to sell, lease, or license to the public, and to enter into contracts concerning certain products, services, and technology or related services; authorizing the adoption of a price structure for a product, service, or technology; requiring that certain expenditures and revenues be accounted for through a separate set of accounts; requiring that profits earned be used for a certain purpose; providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to the authority of the WSSC to market certain products, services, and technology or related services.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
