- (6) Supervisors of pupil personnel I;
- (7) Supervisors of pupil personnel II;
- (8) Visiting teachers;
- (9) Medical inspectors; and
- (10) School nurses.] SHALL EMPLOY INDIVIDUALS IN THE POSITIONS THAT THE COUNTY BOARD CONSIDERS NECESSARY FOR THE OPERATION OF THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS IN THE COUNTY.
  - EXPLANATION: Section 6-201(a) of the Education Article requires that each county employ individuals in specified positions as authorized by the county board of education. The list appears dated and staff recommends that the specified positions in this subsection be replaced with a broad grant of authority to enable the county board to employ individuals in those positions that the board considers necessary. In the alternative, staff recommends that the specified list be expanded to authorize any additional position that a county board of education considers necessary.
