- (ii) enhanced well-being of the standardbred racing industry.
- (2) [Within 90 days after the end of a licensee's fiscal year, each licensee shall submit to the Commission and, subject to § 2–1312 of the State Government Article, the General Assembly:
 - (i) a report that:
- 1. is reviewed by a certified public accountant whom the Commission approves to audit the licensee; and
- 2. specifies how the allocation under this subsection was spent or committed in the past fiscal year of the licensee;
- (ii) an unaudited report on the proposed use of the allocation for the current fiscal year of the licensee; and
 - (iii) any additional information that the General Assembly requires.
- (3)] The General Assembly, by statute, may direct that the Commission not award in the following calendar year part or all of the racing days authorized under § 11-610 of this subtitle to the licensee if the General Assembly finds that:
- (i) the proposed use of the allocation under this subsection is inconsistent with the purposes specified in this section; or
- (ii) the licensee has not spent the allocation in a way that is consistent with the proposal.
