SUBJECT TO § 2-1312 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, THE SECRETARY, IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE SECRETARY OF TRANSPORTATION, SHALL FURNISH A JOINT REPORT TO THE LEGISLATIVE POLICY COMMITTEE, THE SENATE JUDICIAL PROCEEDINGS COMMITTEE, AND THE HOUSE ENVIRONMENTAL MATTERS COMMITTEE:

(1) BY JANUARY 1, 1995, AND BIENNIALY THEREAFTER, THAT PROVIDES UPDATED INFORMATION ON THE STATE'S PROGRESS IN MEETING THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE FEDERAL CLEAN AIR ACT AMENDMENTS OF 1990, INCLUDING CURRENT AND PROJECTED METHODS AND PROGRAMS UTILIZED IN THE STATE TO REDUCE AIR POLLUTION, THE PROJECTED PUBLIC AND PRIVATE COSTS OF THESE METHODS AND PROGRAMS, AND ANY OTHER SIGNIFICANT INFORMATION; AND

(2) WITHIN 30 DAYS AFTER THE DATE CONGRESS MODIFIES THE PROVISIONS OF THE FEDERAL CLEAN AIR ACT, THAT OUTLINES THE STATUS OF CHANGES IN THE FEDERAL CLEAN AIR ACT AS OF THAT DATE AND ALL OTHER RELATED AND PERTINENT INFORMATION.
