- (2) THE TERMS OF APPOINTED MEMBERS SHALL BE STAGGERED.
- (3) AT THE END OF A TERM, AN APPOINTED MEMBER CONTINUES TO SERVE UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED.
- (4) A MEMBER WHO IS APPOINTED AFTER A TERM HAS BEGUN SERVES ONLY FOR THE REST OF THE TERM AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED.
  - (5) A MEMBER SERVES AT THE PLEASURE OF THE SECRETARY.
- (D) THE COMMITTEE SHALL EXERCISE ITS POWERS AND PERFORM ITS DUTIES SUBJECT TO THE AUTHORITY OF THE SECRETARY.
  - (E) THE COMMITTEE SHALL:
- (1) DETERMINE WHETHER TO APPROVE LOAN REQUESTS FROM QUALIFIED APPLICANTS FOR DEFENSE ADJUSTMENT LOANS, AND
  - (2) SET THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR SUCH LOANS.
- (F) THE EXERCISE BY THE COMMITTEE OF THE POWERS GRANTED BY THIS SUBTITLE CONSTITUTES AN ESSENTIAL GOVERNMENT FUNCTION.
- (G) THE COMMITTEE SHALL DETERMINE THE TIMES AND PLACES OF ITS MEETINGS.
- (H) EACH MEMBER OF THE COMMITTEE IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS, AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.
- (I) ANY DETERMINATION BY THE COMMITTEE WITH RESPECT TO FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE UNDER THIS SUBTITLE IS SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE MARYLAND PUBLIC ETHICS LAW.
- (J) THE EXISTENCE OF ANY CONFLICT OF INTEREST OR ANY VIOLATION OF THE MARYLAND PUBLIC ETHICS LAW MAY NOT BE CONSTRUED TO AFFECT:
- (1) THE VALIDITY OF ANY FINDING OR DETERMINATION MADE UNDER THIS SUBTITLE; OR
- (2) THE ENFORCEABILITY OF ANY AGREEMENT ENTERED INTO UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.
- (K) IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER POWERS SET FORTH IN THIS SUBTITLE, THE COMMITTEE MAY:
- (1) ADOPT BYLAWS TO REGULATE ITS AFFAIRS AND THE CONDUCT OF ITS BUSINESS;
  - (2) CONTRACT FOR AND ENGAGE THE SERVICES OF CONSULTANTS;
- (3) ELECT A CHAIRPERSON AND VICE CHAIRPERSON FROM AMONG ITS MEMBERS; AND
