CHAPTER 703**(House Bill 1678)**

AN ACT concerning

Retirement and Pension Systems — ~~Reemployment of Retirees~~

FOR the purpose of permitting a retiree of certain State retirement and pension systems to accept permanent employment with a participating employer without any reduction in the retiree's retirement allowance under certain conditions; providing for a reduction in the retirement allowance under certain conditions; providing for certain exceptions for certain retirees employed on a temporary or contractual basis; prohibiting the receipt of creditable service or eligibility service or the application of certain employee pickup or member contributions during the period of reemployment; requiring the State Retirement Agency to institute certain reporting procedures with certain payroll systems; requiring certain employers participating in certain State retirement and pension systems to provide certain information to the State Retirement Agency; altering the circumstances under which certain Orphans' Court judges may not receive a certain pension; providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to ~~the reemployment of~~ retirees of certain State retirement and pension systems.
