- (vii) Appraisal <u>OF INDIVIDUALS</u>, DIAGNOSIS, AND TREATMENT of individuals WITH MENTAL AND EMOTIONAL DISORDERS;

(VIII) ASSESSMENT AND TREATMENT OF INDIVIDUALS WITH MENTAL AND EMOTIONAL DISORDERS;

- (viii) (IX) (VIII) Research and evaluation; and
- (ix) (XX) (IX) Participation in a supervised practicum in professional counseling; AND
 - (X) MARRIAGE AND FAMILY THERAPY.
- (5) IN THIS SUBSECTION, "TRAINING IN MARRIAGE AND FAMILY THERAPY TRAINING" INCLUDES, BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO, INSTRUCTION IN:
- (I) EIGHT OUT OF THE 10 COURSE CONTENT AREAS LISTED IN PARAGRAPH (4) OF THIS SUBSECTION; AND
 - (II) THE FOLLOWING SPECIALIZED AREAS:
 - \pm (I) ANALYSIS OF FAMILY SYSTEMS;
 - 2 (II) FAMILY THERAPY, THEORY, AND TECHNIQUES;
 - 3. (III) COUPLES THERAPY, THEORY, AND TECHNIQUES;
- 4. (IV) GENDER AND ETHNICITY IN MARRIAGE AND FAMILY THERAPY; AND
- $\stackrel{\Sigma}{=}$ (V) SEXUAL ISSUES IN MARRIAGE AND FAMILY THERAPY.
- (e) Except as otherwise provided in this title, the applicant shall pass an examination approved by the Board under this subtitle.
