SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 27 – Crimes and Punishments

[Spousal Assault] DOMESTIC ABUSE

11F.

(A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

(2) “ABUSE” HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 4-501 OF THE FAMILY LAW ARTICLE.

(3) “VICTIM” INCLUDES A “PERSON ELIGIBLE FOR RELIEF” AS DESCRIBED IN § 4-501 OF THE FAMILY LAW ARTICLE.
