

(1) REQUIRE ANY FORM OF COLLECTIVE BARGAINING;

(2) REQUIRE ANY METHOD, MEANS, OR SCOPE OF BARGAINING BETWEEN AN EMPLOYER AND AN EXCLUSIVE REPRESENTATIVE; OR

(3) AUTHORIZE BINDING INTEREST ARBITRATION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1994.

CHAPTER 734

(House Bill 1154)

AN ACT concerning

Foreign Crab Meat – Markings on Containers

FOR the purpose of requiring that each container of crab meat sold in the State containing crab meat that was picked, packed, repacked, or processed outside of the United States be marked by a certain notice; and generally relating to the labeling of crab meat.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Health – General

21-339.

(b) Each container of crab meat shall be marked plainly with the information required by this section.
