

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, has been passed by a ye and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted.

CHAPTER 6

(Senate Bill 1)

AN ACT concerning

Pension Law – Code Revision

FOR the purpose of adding two new divisions to the State Personnel and Pensions Article, to be designated and known as “Division II – Pensions” and “Division III – Other Retirement and Pension Provisions”, to revise, restate, and recodify the laws of the State relating to State and local retirement and pension systems and other retirement benefits; specifying the scope and application of the laws relating to State and local retirement and pension systems and other retirement benefits; amending certain definitions; defining certain terms; repealing certain inconsistent and obsolete laws; transferring certain provisions of law to the Session Laws; providing for the effect of the Revisor’s Notes contained in this Act; providing for the continuity of certain terms of office; providing for the effect of this Act on any change in nomenclature; providing for the effect, construction, and effective date of the provisions of this Act; and generally relating to State and local retirement and pensions systems and other retirement benefits.
