- (a) In this section, "Council" means the Procurement Advisory Council.
- (b) There is a Procurement Advisory Council.
- (c) (1) The Council consists of the following [7] NINE members:
  - [(1)](I) the State Treasurer;
  - [(2)](II) the Chancellor of the University of Maryland System;
  - [(3)](III) the Secretary of Budget and Fiscal Planning;
  - [(4)](IV) the Secretary of General Services;
  - [(5)](V) the Secretary of Transportation;
  - [(6)](VI) the Secretary of the Board; [and]
- (VII) A REPRESENTATIVE OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT WHO HAS EXPERTISE IN LOCAL PROCUREMENT MATTERS, APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR WITH THE ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE SENATE; AND
- [(7)](VIII) [a member] TWO MEMBERS of the general public, AT LEAST ONE OF WHOM HAS EXPERTISE IN STATE PROCUREMENT MATTERS, APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR WITH THE ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE SENATE.
- (2) (I) IF THE STATE TREASURER IS UNABLE TO ATTEND A MEETING OF THE PROCUREMENT ADVISORY COUNCIL, THE TREASURER MAY DESIGNATE THE DEPUTY TREASURER TO ATTEND THE MEETING.
- (II) IF A MEMBER OF THE COUNCIL LISTED IN PARAGRAPH (1) (II) THROUGH (V) OF THIS SUBSECTION IS UNABLE TO ATTEND A MEETING OF THE PROCUREMENT ADVISORY COUNCIL, THE MEMBER MAY DESIGNATE THE CHIEF PROCUREMENT OFFICER OF THE AGENCY TO ATTEND THE MEETING.
  - (d) The Secretary of the Board is Chairman of the Council.
  - (e) The Council shall meet at least [once a] QUARTERLY EACH year.
- (f) The PROCUREMENT ADVISOR IS THE PRINCIPAL STAFF OF THE COUNCIL AND THE Council shall have [the] ANY ADDITIONAL staff that the Board authorizes in accordance with the State budget.
- (g) [(1) The Council may study and analyze matters within the jurisdiction of the Board.
- (2) As directed by the Board, the Council shall discuss and advise the Board on:
  - (i) problems in the procurement process; and
- (ii) recommendations for improvement of the process.] THE COUNCIL SHALL:
