~~(4) (3) UPON RECEIPT OF AN ORDER OF EXPUNGEMENT, THE DIRECTOR SHALL PURGE THE ANY DNA RECORD AND ALL, DNA SAMPLE, OR OTHER IDENTIFIABLE INFORMATION COVERED BY THE ORDER FROM THE STATEWIDE DNA DATA BASE SYSTEM, SYSTEM AND THE DNA SAMPLE STORED IN THE STATEWIDE DNA REPOSITORY, THAT IS COVERED BY THE ORDER. IF THE PERSON HAS MORE THAN ONE ENTRY IN THE DATA BASE AND REPOSITORY, THEN ONLY THE ENTRY COVERED BY THE EXPUNGEMENT ORDER SHALL BE PURGED.~~

~~(M) (1) A PERSON WHO, BY VIRTUE OF EMPLOYMENT OR OFFICIAL POSITION, HAS POSSESSION OF OR ACCESS TO INDIVIDUALLY IDENTIFIABLE DNA INFORMATION CONTAINED IN THE STATEWIDE DNA DATA BASE SYSTEM OR STATEWIDE DNA REPOSITORY AND WHO WILLFULLY DISCLOSES THAT INFORMATION IN ANY MANNER TO ANY PERSON OR AGENCY NOT ENTITLED TO RECEIVE THAT INFORMATION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000 OR IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 3 YEARS OR BOTH.~~

~~(2) A PERSON WHO, WITHOUT AUTHORIZATION, WILLFULLY OBTAINS INDIVIDUALLY IDENTIFIABLE DNA INFORMATION FROM THE STATEWIDE DNA DATA BASE SYSTEM OR REPOSITORY IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000 OR IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 3 YEARS OR BOTH.~~

(B) (1) THERE IS CREATED WITHIN THE CRIME LABORATORY A STATEWIDE DNA DATA BASE SYSTEM.

(2) THE SYSTEM SHALL BE THE CENTRAL REPOSITORY FOR ALL DNA TESTING INFORMATION AS PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION.

(3) THE DIRECTOR SHALL:

(I) ADMINISTER AND MANAGE THE SYSTEM;

(II) CONSULT WITH THE SUPERINTENDENT ON THE ADOPTION OF APPROPRIATE REGULATIONS CONCERNING SYSTEM PROTOCOLS AND OPERATION;

(III) ENSURE COMPATIBILITY WITH FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION AND CODIS REQUIREMENTS, INCLUDING THE USE OF COMPARABLE TEST PROCEDURES, QUALITY ASSURANCE, LABORATORY EQUIPMENT, AND COMPUTER SOFTWARE; AND

(IV) ENSURE THE SECURITY AND CONFIDENTIALITY OF ALL RECORDS OF THE SYSTEM.

(4) THE SUPERINTENDENT, AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE DIRECTOR, SHALL ADOPT APPROPRIATE REGULATIONS CONCERNING SYSTEM PROTOCOLS AND OPERATION.
