

A STATE EMPLOYEE WHO CAME INTO THE STATE SYSTEM WHILE RETAINING SICK LEAVE AND ANNUAL LEAVE BENEFITS UNDER A COUNTY SYSTEM AND WHO CAME UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 423 OF THE ACTS OF 1971 SHALL BE ENTITLED TO THE SAME FULL CREDIT TOWARD RETIREMENT AS PROVIDED BY THIS SECTION.

TITLE 21. STATE RETIREMENT AND PENSION SYSTEM.

SUBTITLE 1. ADMINISTRATION.

21-101. SYSTEM ESTABLISHED; PURPOSE; STATUS.

(A) ESTABLISHED.

THERE IS A STATE RETIREMENT AND PENSION SYSTEM.

(B) PURPOSE.

THE STATE RETIREMENT AND PENSION SYSTEM SHALL PROVIDE BENEFITS UNDER THIS DIVISION II FOR PARTICIPANTS IN THE SEVERAL SYSTEMS.

(C) STATUS.

THE STATE RETIREMENT AND PENSION SYSTEM HAS THE POWERS AND PRIVILEGES OF A CORPORATION.
