SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Health – General

(c) (1) IN ORDER THAT THE GOVERNOR MAY MEET THE PROVISIONS OF PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, BY NOVEMBER 15 OF EACH YEAR, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADVISE THE GOVERNOR OF THE NET AMOUNT OF ANY FUNDS EXPENDED THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30 OF THE CURRENT FISCAL YEAR FROM THE “WIC” CONTINGENCY RESERVE ACCOUNT ESTABLISHED IN THE DEDICATED PURPOSE ACCOUNT UNDER § 7-310 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.

(2) The Governor shall include in the annual STATE budget [State] general funds of AN AMOUNT EQUIVALENT TO THAT NECESSARY TO RESTORE THE BALANCE IN THE “WIC” CONTINGENCY RESERVE ACCOUNT FOR THE PROGRAM TO at least \$1,000,000 to cover the administrative and food costs of the Program UTILIZED THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30 OF THE CURRENT FISCAL YEAR TO ATTAIN AND MAKE MAXIMUM USE OF FEDERAL FUNDS THAT ARE AVAILABLE ONLY IN THE FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR IN WHICH THEY ARE APPROPRIATED.

(K) (1) THERE IS ESTABLISHED A “WIC” CONTINGENCY RESERVE ACCOUNT WITHIN THE DEDICATED PURPOSE ACCOUNT FOR THE PURPOSE OF MAKING MAXIMUM USE OF FEDERAL FUNDS THAT ARE AVAILABLE ONLY IN THE FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR IN WHICH THEY ARE APPROPRIATED TO FUND THE SPECIAL SUPPLEMENTAL FOOD PROGRAM FOR WOMEN, INFANTS, AND CHILDREN (WIC).
