(2) THE OUTCOME OF ANY EXECUTIVE ACTION RELATING TO THE SOLICITATION OR SECURING OF A PROCUREMENT CONTRACT, AS DEFINED IN § 11–101 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE, OR ON ANY OTHER CONTINGENCY CONNECTED WITH ANY OTHER EXECUTIVE ACTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1994.

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed Senate Bill 525.

This bill would amend the Maryland Food Committee Loan of 1993 to allow the matching fund provided by the Board of Directors of the Maryland Food Committee to include funds received from the State and funds expended prior to the effective date of the Act.

House Bill 1100, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 2, 1994, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign Senate Bill 525.
