21-106. SAME — QUORUM; MEETINGS; EXPENSES.

(A) VOTING.

EACH TRUSTEE IS ENTITLED TO ONE VOTE ON THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES.

(B) QUORUM.

A MAJORITY OF THE TRUSTEES THEN SERVING ON THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES IS A QUORUM FOR:

- (1) THE TRANSACTION OF ANY BUSINESS;
- (2) THE EXERCISE OF ANY POWER; OR
- (3) THE PERFORMANCE OF ANY DUTY AUTHORIZED OR IMPOSED BY LAW.
  - (C) MEETINGS.

THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES SHALL SET THE TIMES AND PLACES OF ITS MEETINGS.

(D) REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES.

A TRUSTEE:

- (1) MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION FROM THE SEVERAL SYSTEMS FOR SERVICE AS A TRUSTEE; BUT
- (2) IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS, AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.
