

(2) "GOVERNMENTAL UNIT" INCLUDES A DEPARTMENT, BOARD, COMMISSION, AGENCY, OR A SUBUNIT IN THE EXECUTIVE, LEGISLATIVE, OR JUDICIAL BRANCH OF STATE GOVERNMENT AND THOSE COUNTY FUNDED STATE ENTITIES SPECIFIED IN ARTICLE 24, § 8-101 OF THE CODE.

(A) THIS SUBTITLE MAY NOT BE CONSTRUED TO AUTHORIZE THE COMMISSION TO EXERCISE REGULATORY AUTHORITY.

(B) CONSISTENT WITH ITS ACCOUNTABILITY AND REPORTING OBLIGATIONS UNDER §§ 9-1810 AND 9-1812 OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE AUTHORITY OF THE COMMISSION IS ADVISORY ONLY.

(A) THERE IS AN EFFICIENCY 2000 COMMISSION.

(B) THE COMMISSION IS AN INDEPENDENT UNIT IN THE STATE GOVERNMENT.

THE COMMISSION CONSISTS OF:

(1) TWO REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH, APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR;

(2) TWO MEMBERS OF THE SENATE OF MARYLAND, ONE OF WHOM SHALL BE FROM THE MINORITY PARTY, APPOINTED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE;

(3) TWO MEMBERS OF THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES, ONE OF WHOM SHALL BE FROM THE MINORITY PARTY, APPOINTED BY THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE;

(4) TWO REPRESENTATIVES OF THE JUDICIAL BRANCH, APPOINTED BY THE CHIEF JUDGE OF THE MARYLAND COURT OF APPEALS;

(5) SEVEN REPRESENTATIVES OF THE BUSINESS COMMUNITY, THREE APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR, TWO APPOINTED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE OF MARYLAND, AND TWO APPOINTED BY THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES;

(6) ~~TWO REPRESENTATIVES~~ ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF ORGANIZED LABOR, APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR;

(7) ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF A LABOR ORGANIZATION REPRESENTING STATE EMPLOYEES, APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR;
