(a) An inspection station or any of its employees may not issue an inspection certificate OR A PROOF OF INSPECTION CERTIFICATE for a vehicle without having inspected its equipment.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1994.

AN ACT concerning

Legislation - Mandates on Local Governments - Notice and Reporting

FOR the purpose of requiring the synopsis of each Senate and House bill that imposes a mandate on a local government to include a certain statement; requiring the fiscal note for each bill that imposes a mandate on a local government to contain a certain statement and certain information; ~~requiring the Governor's office to prepare and submit to the Department of Fiscal Services a certain statement for certain bills that have a fiscal impact on local governments;~~ requiring the Department of Fiscal Services to include in a certain report certain information about legislation enacted by the General Assembly which impacts on local governments; defining a certain term; making stylistic changes; and generally relating to legislation that imposes mandates on local governments.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
