

(I) COOPERATE WITH THE LOCAL CHILD SUPPORT ENFORCEMENT OFFICE IF THE PATERNITY OF ANY OF THE RECIPIENT'S CHILDREN HAS NOT BEEN ESTABLISHED; AND

(II) PARTICIPATE IN JOB SEARCH AND LIFE SKILLS ACTIVITIES AS DEFINED BY PROJECT INDEPENDENCE FOR 1 WEEK.

(4) A RECIPIENT SHALL CONTINUE SUPERVISED JOB SEARCH ACTIVITIES FOR THE NEXT 11 WEEKS FOLLOWING PARTICIPATION IN THE JOB SEARCH AND LIFE SKILLS ACTIVITIES REQUIRED UNDER PARAGRAPH (3)(II) OF THIS SUBSECTION, INCLUDING LIFE SKILLS TRAINING.

(5) IF A RECIPIENT'S JOB SEARCH IS UNSUCCESSFUL, THE RECIPIENT SHALL RECEIVE MORE INTENSIVE CASE MANAGEMENT SERVICES INCLUDING:

(I) AN ASSESSMENT OF THE RECIPIENT'S JOB SKILLS, EDUCATIONAL LEVEL, APTITUDES, AND INTERESTS;

(II) JOB COUNSELING; AND

(III) JOB TRAINING.

(6) A RECIPIENT MAY ONLY BE REQUIRED TO PARTICIPATE IN JOB SEARCH, JOB TRAINING, AND OTHER PILOT PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS TO THE EXTENT THAT NECESSARY CHILD CARE RESOURCES AND TRANSPORTATION ARE AVAILABLE.

~~(D)~~ (E) (1) A RECIPIENT SHALL MAY NOT RECEIVE MORE THAN 18 MONTHLY BENEFIT PAYMENTS, UNLESS:

~~(4)~~ (1) AN EXTENSION IS GRANTED FOR GOOD CAUSE, AS DEFINED BY THE SECRETARY; OR

~~(2)~~ (II) THE RECIPIENT IS EMPLOYED OR PERFORMS COMMUNITY SERVICE, AS REQUIRED BY THE WAIVER REQUIREMENTS OF THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES.

~~(E)~~ THE SECRETARY SHALL ESTABLISH:

~~(1)~~ A SCHEDULE OF SANCTIONS FOR RECIPIENTS WHO FAIL TO COMPLY WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE PILOT; AND

(2) FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SUBSECTION, GOOD CAUSE EXISTS IF:

(I) A RECIPIENT, WITH THE ASSISTANCE OF THE DEPARTMENT, IS UNABLE TO FIND NECESSARY AND SUITABLE CHILD CARE;

(II) A RECIPIENT HAS A VERIFIED ILLNESS WHICH PREVENTS THE RECIPIENT FROM PARTICIPATING IN THE WORK REQUIREMENTS;
