

(5) IN ANY CASE WHERE AFDC BENEFITS ARE REDUCED OR TERMINATED AS A RESULT OF SANCTIONS IMPOSED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION, THE FAMILY ~~WILL~~ SHALL RETAIN ELIGIBILITY FOR:

(I) MEDICAL ASSISTANCE; AND

(II) FOOD STAMPS AT A BENEFIT LEVEL THAT DOES NOT EXCEED THE FOOD STAMP BENEFIT BASED ON THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF AFDC BENEFITS THAT THE RECIPIENT WOULD OTHERWISE HAVE BEEN ENTITLED TO AS INCOME IF A SANCTION WAS NOT IMPOSED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION.

(6) IN ANY CASE WHERE AFDC BENEFITS ARE RESUMED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION, THE INDIVIDUAL OR FAMILY MAY NOT RECOVER ANY GRANTS THAT THE INDIVIDUAL OR FAMILY WOULD HAVE RECEIVED IF THE SANCTION WAS NOT IMPOSED.

(7) THE SECRETARY SHALL ESTABLISH BY REGULATION EXEMPTIONS ~~TO~~ FROM THE SANCTIONS FOR NONCOMPLIANCE WITH THE TRAINING AND WORK RELATED REQUIREMENTS OF THE PILOT.

~~(F) (4) THE SECRETARY SHALL REVISE THE SCHEDULE OF BENEFITS TO BE PAID TO A RECIPIENT UNDER THE AFDC PROGRAM BY ELIMINATING THE INCREMENT IN CASH BENEFITS UNDER THE PROGRAM FOR WHICH THAT RECIPIENT WOULD OTHERWISE BE ELIGIBLE AS A RESULT OF THE BIRTH OF A DEPENDENT CHILD 10 OR MORE MONTHS AFTER BECOMING SUBJECT TO THE PILOT, EXCEPT IN CASES OF RAPE OR INCEST.~~

~~(2) BENEFIT PAYMENTS MAY NOT BE MADE TO ANY OTHER FAMILY FOR THAT CHILD UNLESS PLACED IN THAT HOME BY THE SOCIAL SERVICES ADMINISTRATION.~~

(G) (1) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL, AS APPROPRIATE, REFER THE RECIPIENT TO FAMILY PLANNING COUNSELING AND SERVICES.

(2) FAMILY PLANNING COUNSELING AND SERVICES MAY NOT BE OFFERED OR CONDUCTED IN A MANNER THAT:

(I) WILL HAVE A COERCIVE EFFECT ON THE RECIPIENT; OR

(II) WILL VIOLATE THE RECIPIENT'S BONA FIDE RELIGIOUS BELIEFS AND PRACTICES.

(3) THE DEPARTMENT AND THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE SHALL ~~ENCOURAGE MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PROVIDERS TO PROVIDE~~ FAMILY PLANNING COUNSELING AND SERVICES AT THE OFFICES OF LOCAL DEPARTMENTS OF SOCIAL SERVICES. THESE SERVICES MAY BE PROVIDED THROUGH MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PROVIDERS.
