21-208. AGREEMENT RELIEVING FIDUCIARY FROM LIABILITY.

(A) CERTAIN AGREEMENTS VOID.

EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN § 21–204(B) AND (C) OF THIS SUBTITLE, A PROVISION IN AN AGREEMENT THAT PURPORTS TO RELIEVE A FIDUCIARY FROM A RESPONSIBILITY, OBLIGATION, OR DUTY, OR LIABILITY FOR A RESPONSIBILITY, OBLIGATION, OR DUTY UNDER THIS SUBTITLE IS AGAINST PUBLIC POLICY AND VOID.

(B) INDEMNIFICATION.

THIS SUBTITLE DOES NOT PRECLUDE INDEMNIFICATION OF A FIDUCIARY IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 21–207 OF THIS SUBTITLE.

21-209. DISQUALIFICATION OF FIDUCIARY; PENALTIES.

- (A) DISQUALIFICATION; PROHIBITED ACTS.
- (1) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER LAW, A PERSON MAY NOT SERVE AS A FIDUCIARY IF THE PERSON HAS BEEN CONVICTED OF:
 - (I) A FELONY;
 - (II) A MISDEMEANOR INVOLVING MORAL TURPITUDE:
 - (III) A VIOLATION OF THIS SUBTITLE;
- (IV) A CONSPIRACY OR ATTEMPT TO COMMIT A CRIME DESCRIBED UNDER ITEM (I), (II), OR (III) OF THIS PARAGRAPH; OR
