SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article - Education**

24-204.

(b) (1) The Commission shall have the staff provided in the State budget.

(2) The secretarial, stenographic, clerical, and custodial employees of the Commission are in the classified service of the State Personnel Management System.

(3) All other employees of the Commission are in the unclassified service of the State Personnel Management System.
